Claire was also drawing well but kept finding the gaps and on her third wood managed to get second wood with Jeanette replacing it to win two shots. Going into the last end Jeanette and Sue were 20-17 up. The eighteenth end saw Sue draw shot with Kerrie having second wood. Claire moved the jack with her first wood but still was one down. Jeanette managed to draw another shot winning the game 22-17.
